Resident Advisory Board (RAB) Comments regarding the 2018 YHA Annual and Five Year Agency Plan

Regina Mitchell, Executive Director, met with members of Resident Advisory Board (RAB) at their regular May 9, 2018 meeting and discussed the forthcoming draft Agency Plan. The draft Agency Plan was made public on May 17, 2018, giving the public 45 days for review and comment.

The first public meeting to receive verbal and/or written comments to the draft plan was held on Tuesday, May 22, 2018 at 4pm at York Housing Authority Main Office, 31 S. Broad St., York, PA 17403. There were no attendees representing the residents or the general public.

The second public meeting to receive verbal and/or written comments to the draft plan started at 2pm on May 31, 2018 at the Springfield Apartments, 1930 Kenneth Rd., York, PA 17408. Regina Mitchell, Executive Director and Lynette Burkhart, Property Manager, represented the Agency. There were 14 attendees representing the residents of the general public. An attendance sheet and minutes are attached. The draft Agency Plan was discussed.

On Wednesday, June 13, 2018, the Executive Director met with RAB at their regular 6pm meeting held at the White Rose Senior Center. Paper copies of the 2018 Agency Plan were available for the Members to review and discuss. The RAB Members approved the draft of the Agency Plan so it could move forward to the York Housing Authority Board of Commissioners at the regular meeting on June 26, 2018. There were 11 attendees representing the residents of the YHA public housing community, and Debbie Thomas, YHA Social Services. An attendance sheet and minutes for the June 13th meeting are attached.

The third and final public meeting to discuss the draft plan was held at 4:00pm on June 26, 2018 at the York Housing Authority Main Office, 31 S. Broad St., York, PA 17403. Regina Mitchell, Executive Director and David Schaumann, Esq., Deputy Executive Director represented the Agency. There were two attendees representing the residents or the general public. An attendance sheet is attached. The draft Agency Plan was discussed.

Written comments and feedback to the Community Survey were due by 4pm on June 26, 2018.

The Plan was presented and approved to the Board of Commissioners for approval on June 26, 2018 and was ready to be submitted to HUD. Approval by HUD is anticipated by September 30th.
